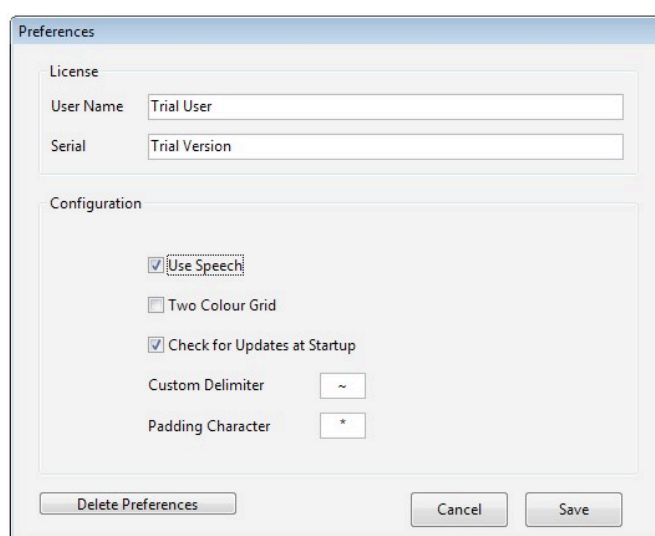
Registering R10Clean

After downloading R10Clean and deciding that you would like a full working copy, you can purchase this directly at the following web address:

www.r10clean.com

Once you have done this we are automatically notified of your purchase and a User Name and Serial Number are sent out to you via email. The Serial Number is tied to your Name and the two must be used in conjunction.

When you receive the serial number email you should launch R10Clean and access the Preferences menu item. The Preferences window that opens will look slightly different depending on the Operating System that you are using, they are all however very similar and contain identical information. The Preferences window for Windows Vista looks like this:



The User Name and Serial Number that you received in your email from Arten Science should be entered into the appropriate fields on the Preferences window. To avoid typing errors we suggest you Copy / Paste the information.

Once you have entered the information you should push the Save button. If the information is correct the Trial Version Overlay / Window will disappear and the product is then fully licensed. Keep the email from Arten Science safe as you will need it should you need to reinstall in future on a new computer.

Our licensing allows one purchase to be installed on two computers that you own, for example your desktop and also your laptop. Please respect our efforts and purchase additional licenses if you need to install on multiple computers. We also offer site licenses for corporations.

Introduction

R10Clean is a Cross Platform Utility designed to make it straightforward to 'clean' large amounts of data. Data can be imported from a CSV or TAB delimited file, modified (any column, any row) and then saved back in several different formats including native Excel (XLS), TAB Delimited and Comma Separated. You can also save the modified file using your own Custom Delimiter.

The grid size restriction of R10Clean are:

Rows, limited only by available memory
Columns, 60

R10Clean supports the following Actions:

Remove

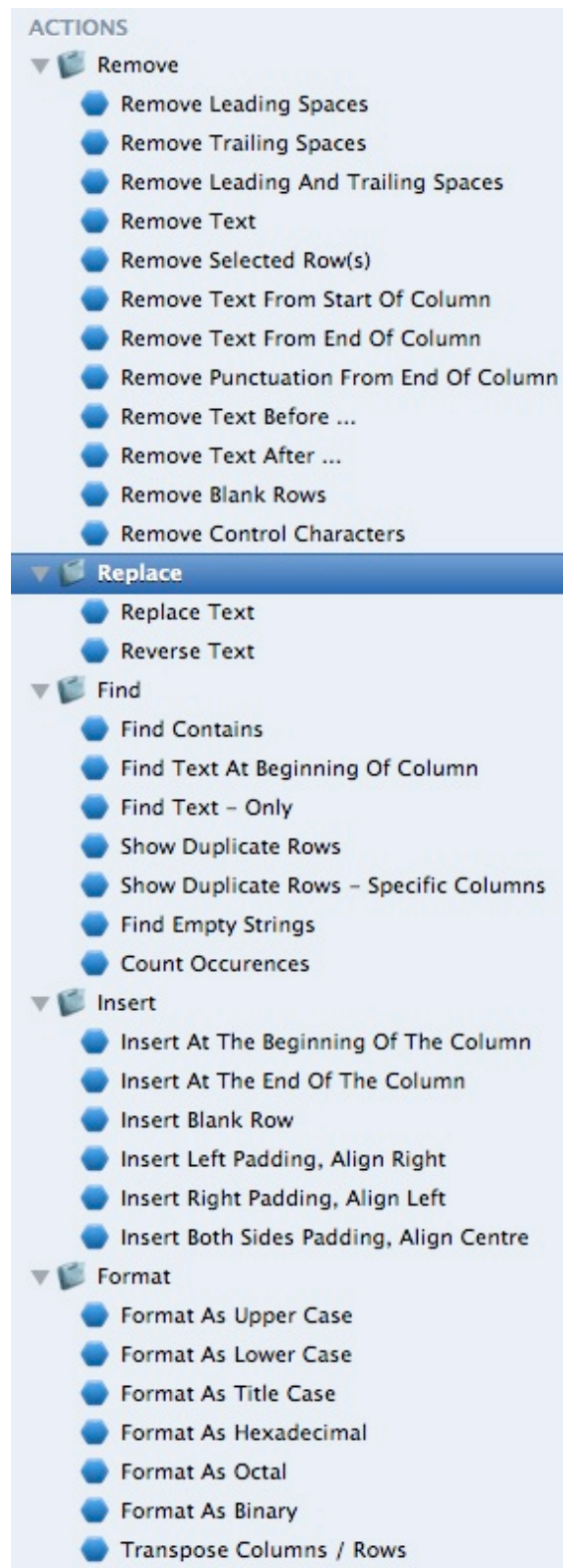
Replace

Find

Insert

Format

Within each Action R10Clean provides **Tasks** that you can apply to the data grid. Tasks include the following:

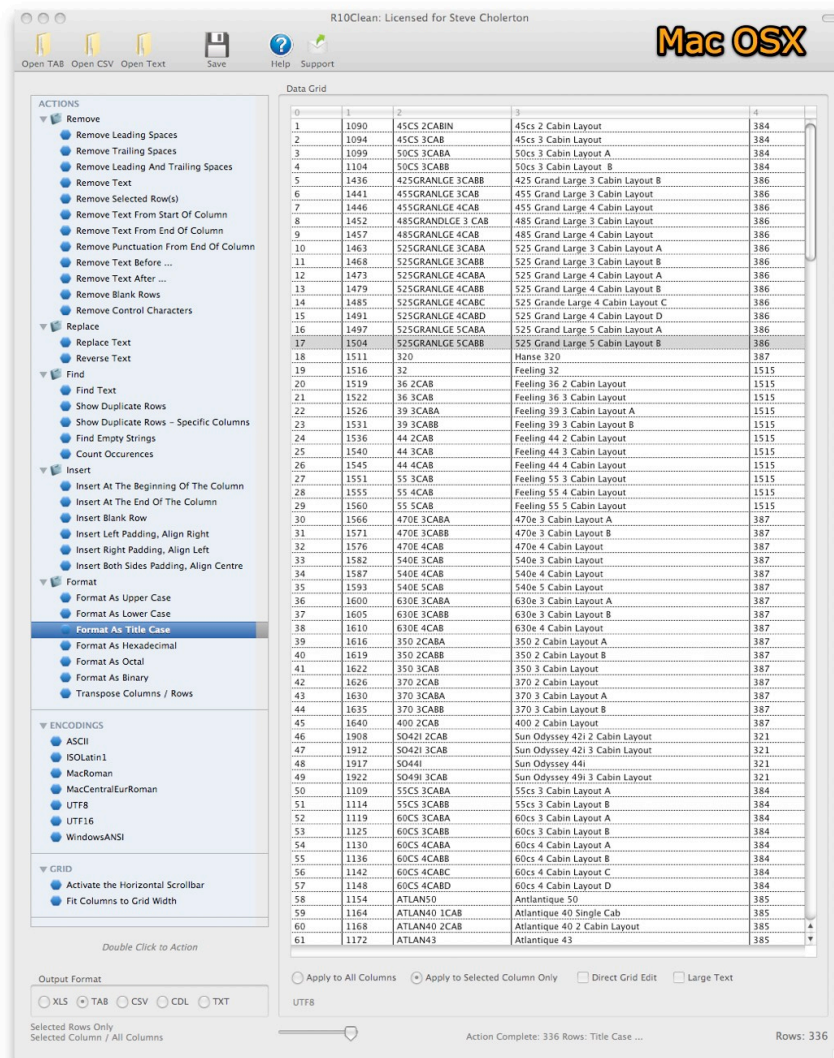


Quick Start

After downloading, unzip the file. Your operating system may do this automatically for you. Drag the file / folder to a convenient location on your hard disk. Double click the R10Clean file to launch the program.

Note: Users of Linux may have to view the file permissions and set the 'execute' flag.

You will see the R10Clean main screen. The OSX version is shown below:



Open a tab delimited or comma separated file using the toolbar buttons and the file will be displayed in the Data Grid. Now you can manipulate the contents of the Data Grid using the Tasks available within each Action Category.

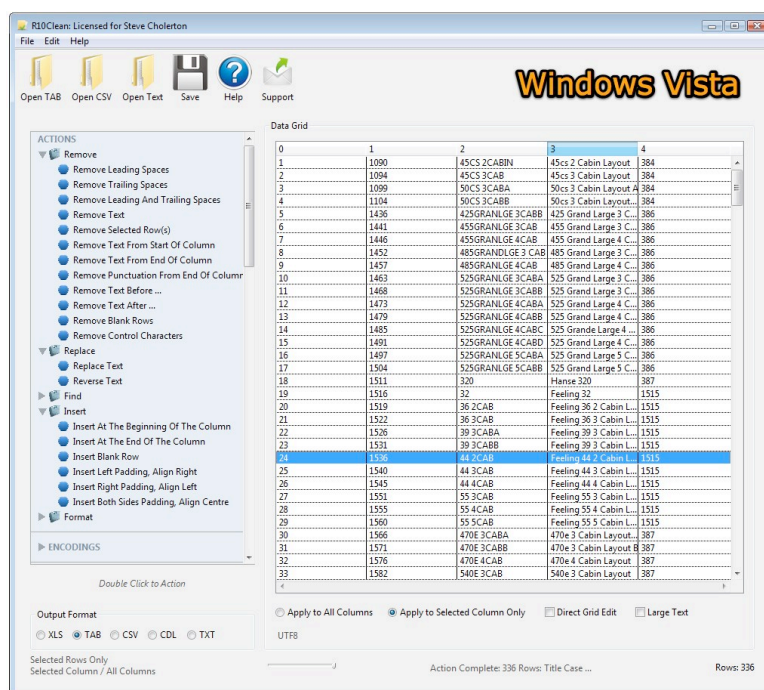
You can apply changes to all columns or selected columns only, and in most cases changes are applied to only the selected rows. Each cell in the grid can be edited individually using the 'Direct Grid Edit' checkbox at the bottom of the window.

Once you have completed the manipulation you can save the Data Grid in a choice of several different formats.

Windows

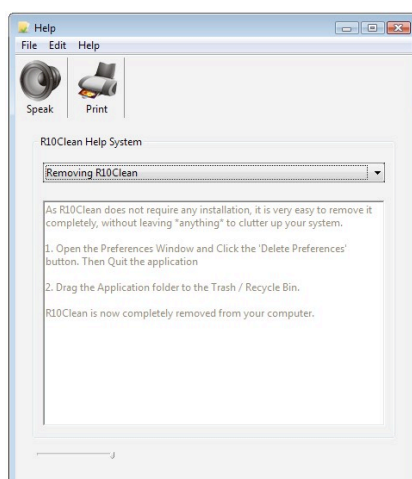
The Main Window

This is where the majority of interaction with R10Clean is carried out. Each toolbar button has a tooltip which is visible when you hover your mouse cursor over the button for a second. Note the 'slider' in the bottom left of the window. This slider controls the transparency settings for the window. Transparency settings as well as window size and position are saved when you quit the software. The Main Window running on Windows Vista is shown below:



The Help Window

The Help Window is accessed from either the Help option on the Menu or via the Help button on the Toolbar. You can choose a number of help topics from the drop down menu. The Help window from Windows Vista is shown below:



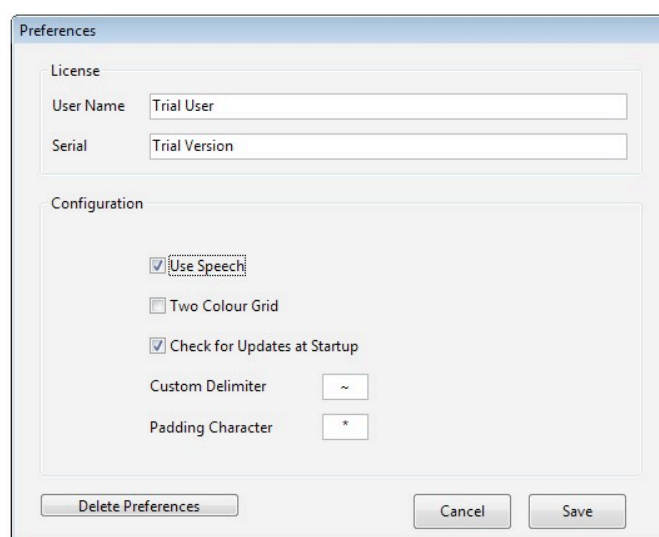
The About Window

The About Window is accessed from the Menu and displays information relating to R10Clean, Copyright, Version and other information. The About Window from Mac OSX is shown below:



The Preferences Window

The Preferences Window is where you input your user name and serial number and where you can set the preferences for R10Clean. The Preferences Window from Windows Vista is shown below:

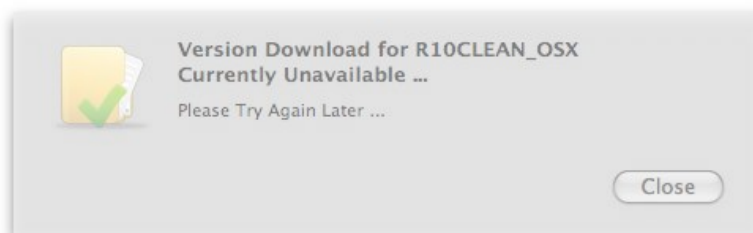


Menus

The menu options for certain actions such as About and Preferences display in different places on the menu bar according to the interface guidelines defined by the operating system. Therefore the order of these menu option descriptions may differ depending on your operating system platform. The order I have used is left to right, top to bottom for Mac OSX.

Check for Updates

This option manually checks for updates to R10Clean. If an update exists you will be given the option to download it. If it doesn't you will see a screen similar to this:



About R10Clean

This option displays the About window as detailed previously.

Preferences

This option displays the Preferences window as detailed previously.

Send Feedback

This option opens your email client with a new message. This message contains information about the version of the software you are running, as well as which operating system you are using. You can add text to this email to send us information, requests or feedback as appropriate.

Visit Our Website

This option opens our website in your default internet browser.

R10Clean Help

This option opens the Help window as detailed previously.

Trial Version Limitations

The Trial Version of R10Clean is limited to working with data-sets not exceeding 50 rows.

Removing R10Clean

To remove R10Clean completely from your system, follow these steps:

1. Go the Preferences window and click the 'Delete Preferences' button and then close the application.
2. Drag the R10Clean folder to the Trash / Recycle Bin.

R10Clean is now completely removed from your system.
